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Strong Kids: The need to raise funds for our Strong Kids Fund ensures that those most vulnerable in our community have the opportunity to access services of the YMCA and be treated with respect. The need for assistance has increased and we need to raise \$225,000 in 2021/2022.

Year over year, we see an increase in numbers of children and their families facing financial hardships as the cost-of-living increases, there is more unemployment and recently experiencing the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. In the 2019/2020 school year we assisted 90 children to access the Before & After School Programs by providing caregiver assistance for almost \$79,000.

The ability of the YMCA to offer programs and services is essential to the community, as is evident in the assistance provided to access subsidized memberships for over 1400 individuals over the last 3 years. *We anticipate the need to provide safe and affordable programming access over the next three years, we need to raise \$675,000 to ensure all families in our community have access to these various services.* We believe in the potential and worth of every person that everyone has leadership potentials.

YChampions: The need to raise funds for our YChampions Fund ensures that those most vulnerable adults and community partners in the community have the opportunity to access services of the YMCA and be treated with respect. The need for assistance has increased and we need to raise \$68,000 in 2021/2022.

Year over year, we see an increase in the numbers of adults and various community groups facing financial hardships as the cost-of-living increases or the lowering of government supports experiencing the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. In the 2019/2020 YMCA fiscal year we assisted 808 adults to access YMCA programs/Services by providing assistance. In the 2020/21 fiscal year, we are already at 838 adults receiving support and the need will increase along with alternative programs to meet adult programs for the future.

The ability of the YMCA to offer programs and services is essential to the community. Having the community give back to those who need it provides hope as we believe in the potential and worth of every person that everyone has leadership potentials.

Imagine Fund: The need to raise funds for our Imagine Fund ensures that the YMCA is continually in a position as an organization to complete renovations, upgrades and programs in our Downtown location. This would ensure those located in/around the city centre continue to have the opportunity to access services of the YMCA.

With a building that is over 50 years old, we see an increase in continued upgrades & renovations needing to be completed that can not be covered with the standard membership costs. This has become even more evident as we experienced the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The ability of the YMCA to offer programs and services is essential to the community, as is evident in the ability to provide memberships 2000 individuals over the last 3 years. *We anticipate the need to provide safe and affordable access to health & wellness services and we need to raise \$630,000 to ensure the DOWNTOWN YMCA is continually updated, secure & welcoming centre for the community have access to the various services.* We believe in the potential and worth of every person and that everyone has leadership potentials, we want them to have a place to explore those options.
